## Fresh Locally Grown Vegetables



**What is a CSA?:** Community Supported Agriculture. You purchase a share of the season's harvest in advance from a local farm like Down to Earth. You then will share both the bounty and risk of growing vegetables with the farmers.

**Down to Earth CSA:** We grow our crops using organic methods and practices. The 2019 season will be our 14<sup>th</sup> season in Stafford. Our season runs from mid April through early November. Harvest begins in mid June and continues for about 20 weeks. A typical share may average out to about 8-10 pounds per week and will include around 30 different vegetables over the course of the season.

**What is a Share?:** We offer two different types of shares: Working (our basic share), which many people enjoy because they get to be involved, by helping in the fields for 2 hours every other week throughout the season. This type of share makes our CSA quite unique. We also offer conventional, Nonworking shares (limited) for a more traditional experience at a somewhat higher cost. There also are Small Shares available, containing approximately half the quantity of regular full shares.
